### Collect

Merciful God, your Son came to save us and bore our sins on the cross: may we trust in your mercy and know your love, rejoicing in the righteousness that is ours through Jesus Christ our Lord.

### Post Communion

Lord God, the source of truth and love, keep us faithful to the apostles' teaching and fellowship, united in prayer and the breaking of bread, and one in joy and simplicity of heart, in Jesus Christ our Lord.

### 1st Reading: Song of Solomon 2. 8-13

The voice of my beloved! Look, he comes, leaping upon the mountains, bounding over the hills. <sup>9</sup> My beloved is like a gazelle or a young stag. Look, there he stands behind our wall, gazing in at the windows, looking through the lattice. <sup>10</sup> My beloved speaks and says to me: 'Arise, my love, my fair one, and come

away; <sup>11</sup> for now the winter is past, the rain is over and gone. <sup>12</sup> The flowers appear on the earth; the time of singing has come, and the voice of the turtle-dove is heard in our land. <sup>13</sup> The fig tree puts forth its figs, and the vines are in blossom; they give forth fragrance. Arise, my love, my fair one, and come away.

### Gospel: St Matthew 16. 24-28

Jesus told his disciples, 'If any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me. <sup>25</sup> For those who want to save their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for my sake will find it. <sup>26</sup> For what will it profit them if they gain the whole world but forfeit their

life? Or what will they give in return for their life? <sup>27</sup> 'For the Son of Man is to come with his angels in the glory of his Father, and then he will repay everyone for what has been done. <sup>28</sup> Truly I tell you, there are some standing here who will not taste death before they see the Son of Man coming in his kingdom.'
