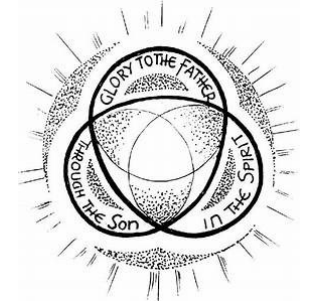

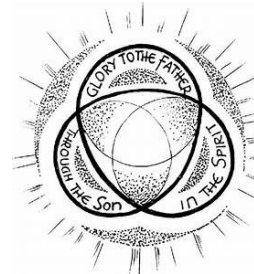

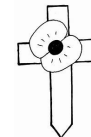

### FIRST AID VOLUNTEERS:

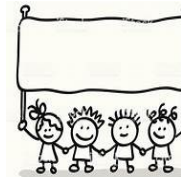
