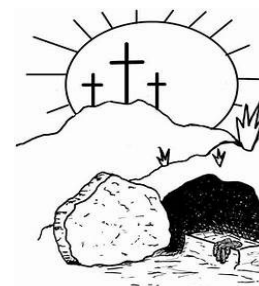

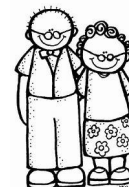

Collect

True & humble king, hailed by the crowd as Messiah: grant us the faith to know you & love you, that we may be found beside you on the way of the cross, which is the path of glory.

Lord Jesus Christ, you humbled yourself in taking the form of a servant, and in obedience died on the cross for our salvation: give us the mind to follow you and to proclaim you as Lord and King, to the glory of God the Father.

Palm Sunday Blessing of Palms

Leader: Fear not, Jerusalem! Your king comes to you meekly riding on a donkey.

ALL: Hosanna to the Son of David,

Leader: Ride on in the cause of truth and for the sake of justice.

ALL: Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.

Leader: Your throne is the throne of God and will endure for ever; the sceptre of your kingdom is the sceptre of righteousness. **ALL: Hosanna to the Son of David. Hosanna in the highest!**

Leader: Dear friends in Christ, today we begin the season of holy week with the church throughout the world. Christ enters his own city to complete his work as our Saviour, to suffer, to die and to rise again. We share his journey so that, united with him in his sufferings, we may also share in his risen life.

Please hold up your palm crosses for a prayer

Loving Father your Son Jesus Christ entered Jerusalem as Messiah to suffer & to die; by your blessing, let these palms be to us a sign of his victory, & grant that we who bear them in his name may ever hail him as our King & follow him in the way that leads to eternal life. **Amen**
