### Reading: Song of Solomon 3. 1

Upon my bed at night I sought him whom my soul loves; I sought him, but found him not; I called him, but he gave no answer.

<sup>2</sup>I will rise now and go about the city, in the streets and in the squares; I will seek him whom my soul loves.' I sought him, but found him not. <sup>3</sup>The

sentinels found me, as they went about in the city. 'Have you seen him whom my soul loves?'<sup>4</sup> Scarcely had I passed them, when I found him whom my soul loves. I held him, and would not let him go until I brought him into my mother's house, and into the chamber of her that conceived me.

### Gospel: St. Luke 10.38 –end

Now as Jesus and his disciples went on their way, he entered a certain village, where a woman named Martha welcomed him into her home. <sup>39</sup>She had a sister named Mary, who sat at the Lord's feet and listened to what he was saying. <sup>40</sup>But Martha was distracted by her many tasks; so she came to him and

asked, 'Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me to do all the work by myself? Tell her then to help me.' <sup>41</sup>But the Lord answered her, 'Martha, Martha, you are worried and distracted by many things;<sup>42</sup> there is need of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part, which will not be taken away from her.'
