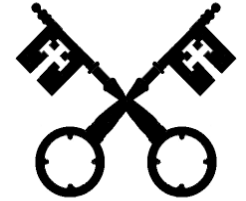

**Gospel: St Mark 10. 13-16**



People were bringing little children to him in order that he might touch them; and the disciples spoke sternly to them.<sup>14</sup> But when Jesus saw this, he was indignant and said to them, 'Let the little children come to me; do not

stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of God belongs.<sup>15</sup> Truly I tell you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will never enter it.'<sup>16</sup> And he took them up in his arms, laid his hands on them, and blessed them.
