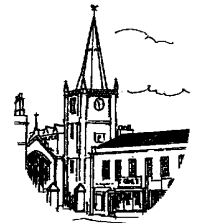

**Reading: 1 John 3. 16-22**

<sup>16</sup>We know love by this, that he laid down his life for us—and we ought to lay down our lives for one another. <sup>17</sup>How does God’s love abide in anyone who has the world’s goods and sees a brother or sister in need and yet refuses help? <sup>18</sup>Little children, let us love, not in word or speech, but in truth and action. <sup>19</sup>And by this we will know that we are

from the truth and will reassure our hearts before him <sup>20</sup>when-ever our hearts condemn us; for God is greater than our hearts, and he knows every-thing. <sup>21</sup>Beloved, if our hearts do not condemn us, we have bold-ness before God; <sup>22</sup>and we re-ceive from him whatever we ask, because we obey his command-ments and do what pleases him.

**Gospel: St Mark 10. 35-45**

James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came forward to him and said to him, ‘Teacher, we want you to do for us whatever we ask of you.’ <sup>36</sup>And he said to them, ‘What is it you want me to do for you?’ <sup>37</sup>And they said to him, ‘Grant us to sit, one at your right hand and one at your left, in your glory.’ <sup>38</sup>But Jesus said to them, ‘You do not know what you are asking. Are you able to drink

the cup that I drink, or be bap-tized with the baptism that I am baptized with?’ <sup>39</sup>They replied, ‘We are able.’ Then Jesus said to them, ‘The cup that I drink you will drink; and with the baptism with which I am baptized, you will be baptized; <sup>40</sup>but to sit at my right hand or at my left is not mine to grant, but it is for those for whom it has been prepared.’ <sup>41</sup>When the ten heard this, they

began to be angry with James and John. <sup>42</sup>So Jesus called them and said to them, ‘You know that among the Gentiles those whom they recognize as their rulers lord it over them, and their great ones are tyrants over them. <sup>43</sup>But it is not so among you; but whoever

wishes to become great among you must be your servant, <sup>44</sup>and whoever wishes to be first among you must be slave of all. <sup>45</sup>For the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life a ransom for many.’
