

Collect

Most merciful God, who by the death and resurrection of your Son Jesus Christ delivered and saved the world: grant that by faith in him who suffered on the cross we may triumph in the power of his victory; through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

Reading: Hebrews 5. 5-10

Christ did not glorify himself in becoming a high priest, but was appointed by the one who said to him, 'You are my Son, today I have begotten you';⁶ as he says also in another place, 'You are a priest for ever, according to the order of Melchizedek.'⁷ In the days of his flesh, Jesus offered up prayers and supplications, with loud cries and tears, to the one who was able to save

Gospel: St John 12. 20-33

Among those who went up to worship at the festival were some Greeks.²¹ They came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee, and said to him, 'Sir, we wish to see Jesus.'²² Philip went and told Andrew; then Andrew and Philip went and told Jesus.²³ Jesus answered them, 'The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified.'²⁴ Very truly, I tell you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains just a single grain; but if it dies, it bears much fruit.²⁵ Those who love their life

him from death, and he was heard because of his reverent submission.⁸ Although he was a Son, he learned obedience through what he suffered;⁹ and having been made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him,¹⁰ having been designated by God a high priest according to the order of Melchizedek.

lose it, and those who hate their life in this world will keep it for eternal life.²⁶ Whoever serves me must follow me, and where I am, there will my servant be also. Whoever serves me, the Father will honour.²⁷ Now my soul is troubled. And what should I say—"Father, save me from this hour"? No, it is for this reason that I have come to this hour.²⁸ Father, glorify your name.' Then a voice came from heaven, 'I have glorified it, and I will glorify it again.'²⁹ The crowd standing

there heard it and said that it was thunder. Others said, 'An angel has spoken to him.'³⁰ Jesus answered, 'This voice has come for your sake, not for mine.'³¹ Now is the judgement of this world; now

the ruler of this world will be driven out.³² And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself.'³³ He said this to indicate the kind of death he was to die.
